






## A Kaleidoscope of cultures

## Where we started

Among the 17 first European Universities Alliances selected in July 2019, the CIVIS journey started with the ambition to become a space for innovative and responsible teaching, research, cultural exchanges and citizen action within Europe.

Our Global Strategy puts a special focus on the Mediterranean region and Africa, rooted in the belief that our future is interconnected.

During our pilot phase, we developed a participative governance structure, deployed mobility initiatives and took the first steps to build our inter-university campus, among other achievements.





## How it's going

The CIVIS journey is gaining traction and some areas are running at full steam. Our Alliance has organised over 150 Blended Intensive Programmes combining online teaching with a physical mobility for our students.

More than 62 Innovative Pedagogy Workshops have brought innovation to the centre of our teaching.

Joint research is blossoming too. CIVIS set up a joint Research Council and our Alliance is providing seed funding to nearly 30 projects that facilitate African-European collaboration.

Structurally, a legal entity supports the long-term vision and goals of our Alliance.





## Our destination


True to our vision, we are builiding a European Universities Alliance where innovative and challenge-base teaching can thrive, all while embedding our actions in our communities.
