ENHANCED CONNECTIONS...

The ARC has enlivened my research massively in small and big ways. New connections have had all sorts of ripple effects. Existing relationships have been strengthened. Working physically closer to colleagues that had been scattered across campus has facilitated greater collaboration.

The open plan working and inclusivity of events has provided an opportunity to broaden my network.

Being in an environment in which I meet colleagues from other Colleges/disciplines has been incredibly beneficial. Conversations happen day-to-day, I can seek advice, I hear about activities/proposals I might not otherwise.

It has made interaction with other teams significantly easier, friendlier, and more productive, and I think has really contributed to the "water cooler effect" of enabling chance conversations that help solve a problem or develop novel initiatives.

The ARC has added significant value to our research & also enabled crossdisciplinary working and diversification of output.

ARC across both academic and professional services colleagues, who are working creatively to build new possibilities for research.

I have been able to attract major global companies as external partners as a result of them visiting the ARC

Facilitation of collaboration with colleagues from other Schools and Colleges, leading to four major UKRI funding applications - 2 successful, 1 currently under consideration and another currently being developed.

By its nature, it has drawn a critical mass of people who I feel are on the same page in terms of appetite for change and optimism and enthusiasm for trying something different; where institutional and sector issues are recognised but not simply complained about but enthusiastically responded to.


Being an ARC resident gives me access to wonderful facilities for everything from senior stakeholder and partner meetings to community co-development and creative activities.
